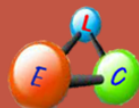

Dance 'till you drop - to dance until you are so tired that you cannot dance any more.



You can make a rainbow indoors.

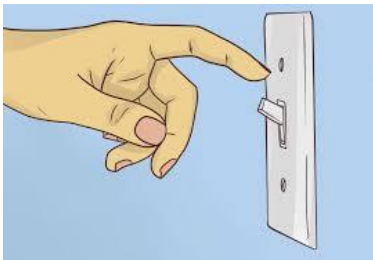


First, put water in a glass.

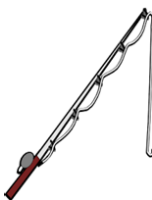

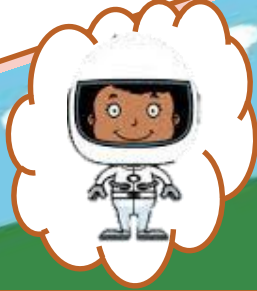
